SUBJECT: Dining Facility Utilization Authorization

1. This letter provides guidance on authorization to eat in the base dining facility in accordance with AFI 34-239, Food Service Management Program. The following personnel are authorized to use the dining facility based on my determination that the dining facility has adequate capacity and the service will not have an impact on the service provided for Essential Station Messing (ESM) and TDY travelers who are not receiving the meal portion of per diem.

a. TDY officers and enlisted who are receiving the meal portion of per diem are authorized to eat in the dining facility when it is authorized on their TDY orders. If receiving the meal portion of per diem member must pay the standard rate which is the a la carte food cost plus surcharge.

b. In recognition of the limited dining alternatives, prohibitions against going off base in uniform and curfew restrictions, all American military personnel officer and enlisted are authorized to use the dining facility. These individuals must pay the standard rate which is the a la carte food cost plus surcharge. This policy will be revised if it imposes an undue hardship on ESM (dorm residents), who are the dining facility's primary customers.

c. Until further notice, all guest DoDDS youth groups and sports teams are authorized to eat in the Sultan's Inn dining facility while visiting Incirlik AB or the local area for scholastic enrichment or athletic competition. Members and chaperones of organized non-profit youth groups are permitted to eat in the dining facility when extended the privilege of visiting the base.

d. All command sponsored civilians assigned to Incirlik AB may utilize the Sultan's Inn dining facility between the hours of 0100 and 0430 Saturday and Sunday.

e. In the best interest of the base populace and due to the limited options available on Incirlik AB, I authorize use of the dining facility to all military active duty both enlisted and officer, DoD civilians and their family members for holiday meals. Holiday meals and hours authorized are for Thanksgiving Day from 1100 to 1400 and 1630 to 2000 and Christmas, 25 December from 1100 to 1400 and 1630 to 2000.

f. All DoDDS teachers assigned to Incirlik AB may utilize the Sultan's Inn dining facility from 0530 through 0630, Mondays through Fridays.

g. Dependents are authorized to dine with their sponsor while residing in lodging in conjunction with a PCS IN/OUT.

h. All retired CMSgts attending the monthly Chief's Group Meeting may utilize the Sultan's Inn dining facility during breakfast hours Mondays through Fridays.

2. In order to maintain appropriate safety and appearance standards, the following dress code is mandatory at the Sultan's Inn dining facility.

a. Military uniforms will be worn as specified in AFI 36-2903, Dress and Personnel Appearance of Air Force Personnel.

b. Civilian dress must be clean, in good repair and in good taste. Printed slogans must not be offensive in nature or contain profanity.

c. Shoes must be worn in the facility and hats will not be worn inside.

d. Swimwear and soiled athletic clothing are not authorized. Athletic clothing appropriate for street wear is authorized provided that it is clean and not inappropriately revealing. Attire that is inappropriately revealing (e.g., exposing the chest, midriff or buttocks) is not authorized.
